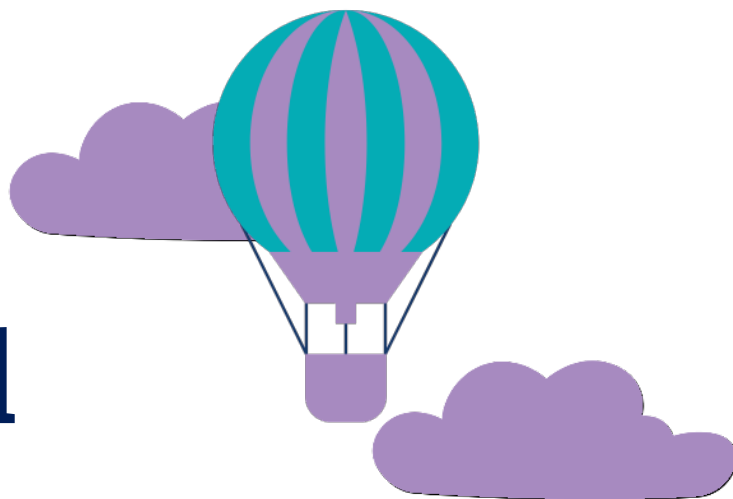

# How to get started



## HOW TO ENROL AND BOOK

1. Please email [oshc@pc.wa.edu.au](mailto:oshc@pc.wa.edu.au) with the requested dates to check for availability
2. To enrol, visit [Xplor Enrolment](#)
3. Download **Xplor App** and set up log-in details
4. Set up payment details on the **Xplor Parent** portal
5. Sign Complying Written Arrangement and approve the service on MyGov if you are claiming the Child Care subsidy
6. Provide immunisations records and medical plans (if required)
7. Bookings can be made through the **Xplor Home app** by selecting the dates and time (8.00 to 6.00 pm)

*Existing users of the OSHC program may already have an online account set up. Please do not complete a new online enrolment.*

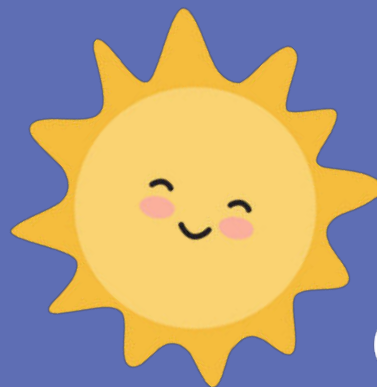
## FEES

Payment for the Vacation Care program, including any additional costs for excursions and incursions, will be debited from your nominated bank account through Xplor.

**The cost each day will be \$90 per child, per day (\$100 if booking is made less than a week's notice).** Excursions and incursions incur an additional cost to the daily fee and are clearly marked in the program.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

We do require 5 days notice for cancellation of a place at Out of School Hours Care or payment will be charged in full, unless a medical certificate is provided.



## What to bring

Children are required to bring their morning tea, lunch and a refillable drink bottle.

Please ensure that you **do not send your child with any food containing nuts** - this includes Nutella. Afternoon tea is provided.

Children must bring a hat, comfortable weather-appropriate clothes and enclosed shoes, as we often have outdoor play. Please **no flip flops or open sandals**. Please pack spare clothes, especially if your child is in Early Childhood.
