LOVE OF LEARNING

Our students learn through hands-on experiences, frequent excursions, play and enquiry that connects multiple learning areas for practical and forward-thinking education. The opportunity to integrate their own interests into activities means that students build a love for learning and a strong sense of curiosity.

BUILDING STRONG CHARACTER

Students are encouraged to participate in diverse activities to support skills around public speaking, peer relationships, mentoring of younger students, and maintaining healthy friendships. School camp at every year level provides opportunities for students to venture out of their comfort zone.

STRONG TEACHER PARTNERSHIPS

Our small class sizes allow each student to receive a lot of attention and support. Students develop close relationships with their teachers and address them by first name, one of many reasons that they feel comfortable to reach out for academic or pastoral support when required.

TEACHER AUTONOMY
